**COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

It will begin with a two-week introduction to IT that will teach and strengthen the basics of computing and digital technology-related topics, such as Microsoft Office and online communication.

Following this, the main Essential Digital Skills programme will begin, teaching participants the 5 categories of Essential Digital skills, to apply for jobs, access important services, and use online tools to connect with friends, colleagues, and customers.

This programme, focuses on developing digital skills for life and introducing learners to digital skills for work.
